CCLM Bible Ministry School Statement of Faith

We believe that The Holy Scriptures, composed of the Old Testament and the New Testament, are fully inspired by God, inerrant in the original writing, completely trustworthy in all areas in which they speak, and the supreme and final authority in faith and practice.

We believe that there is one Almighty and Perfect God who exists eternally as the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, three distinct persons yet one God.

We believe in Jesus the Christ, the Eternal Son of God who took on human flesh, conceived by the power and authority of the Holy Spirit in the virgin birth, dwelt among humanity as the only mediator between God and man, revealed the perfect nature of the Father, gave himself as the only perfect sacrifice for our sins and conquered death in his bodily resurrection. He will one day personally return at the consummation of the age to judge the just and the unjust.

We believe in the Holy Spirit who is eternally God and author of the regeneration and sanctification of every believer. He is the giver of spiritual fruit and gifts, indwells the redeemed as an abiding Comforter and Teacher, and unites believers as one body.
